Census Records

The U.S. Federal Census is one of the most popular resources for genealogists. Access to the actual census provides information about family members residing in the same home, and even lets you see who the neighbors were.

Currently, the census data for the years 1790 to 1930 have been made public. Census data is released 72 years after it is taken for privacy reasons. The 1940 census data will be available in 2012.

Are you wondering why it seems like there was a huge population increase in 1850? No, they didn't just become better at counting. The census information collected prior to 1850 was limited to the head of household.

The results below were obtained from Ancestry.com, the only company currently offering indexed, searchable access to all census years.

Birth Records

Birth certificates are the result of relatively modern legislated vital registration. They provide the essential elements researchers look for in a birth record: names of the child, father, and mother (sometimes with maiden name), place and date of birth.

Baptismal records can be also useful for ancestors whose denominations practiced infant baptism as the religious ceremony took place shortly after the child's birth, usually within a few weeks.

Aside from original certificates, these vital records appear in indexes published by individual states, annual town reports, and other research collections.

Church Membership

Some of the best vital records of our ancestors' lives can be found in church records. This is most significant during the age before state, county, and local governments began complying with legislation to issue birth and death certificates.

In addition to vital records, the membership records of churches can serve as a guide to the migration of your ancestors within this country. Regardless of their circumstances, most would register with the church upon arriving in a new town as they often travelled to find better opportunities.

Marriage Records

Marriage records often contain detailed information including places of birth and current residence, occupations, parents' names and birth places, and previous marriages of the bride and groom. Even something as basic as the couple's signatures can be invaluable in deciphering other handwritten documents.

Years ago, when a couple planned to marry, the prospective groom would take out a bond from the clerk with the county court of the bride's residence. These marriage bonds can be helpful in determining the approximate date of the marriage whenever marriage books and/or church records cannot be located.

Immigration records (including passenger lists and naturalizations) are also among the most valued records for family historians. These documents provide clues to an important piece in the story of our ancestors' arrival in this country.

Military Service

Just about every male on your family tree would have been a candidate for military service. During the American Revolution, men aged 16 to 60 were considered fit for service, and in certain periods of our history, enlistment was mandatory.

The 1930 census documents an individual's military service, stating whether the person was a veteran of the U.S. military or naval forces, and even listing wars or expeditions that they may have served in.

Frequently overlooked resources include Civil War Pension records and draft registration cards.

Death Records

Death records can be located in death indexes, funeral notices, obituaries in newspapers, cemetery records and even remembrance (or mass) cards. In addition, the Social Security Death index is a fantastic resource for more recent deaths.

Sources of death information that researchers don't often consider are the publications of clubs and societies. Many of these organizations kept careful records of their members' passings, even when they have relocated to other towns or states.
